S CALL FOR PAPERS

Authors are invited to submit abstracts and papers contributing to the given symposium topics. The authors are kindly asked to submit the abstract written in English by the given deadline. Each abstract should have a maximum of 200 words.

The authors can submit abstract(s) only or abstract(s) followed by the full paper(s). In both cases, an oral presentation or poster session exhibition is mandatory for the main event. The full paper should be prepared according to instructions available on the official symposium website **www.sorta2024.org**.

Peer-reviewed full papers will be published in the Proceedings of the SORTA 2024 symposium that will be submitted to be indexed in Scopus and/or WoSCC/CPCI. All abstracts will be published in the Book of Abstracts of the SORTA 2024 symposium.

The official language of SORTA 2024 is English.

ACCOMODATION

The SORTA 2024 symposium will be held mostly on the premises of the University of Zadar. The organization of accommodation is left to the participants of the symposium.
